Donating to the Re-Store

All donations made to the CSC Habitat for Humanity Re-Store are tax-deductible. You can make your tax-deductible donations knowing your valuable gift will support CSC Habitat's housing ministry and help a low-income family in the Midlands realize the American dream of homeownership. For Habitat homeowners, this dream would likely never become a reality through conventional means. But with CSC Habitat's housing ministry, seemingly impossible dreams are coming true all the time - one home at a time.

The Re-Store is an ideal outlet for individuals and businesses that are moving or remodeling, as well as for businesses that are closing. The Re-Store is also a beneficial alternative to discarding surplus materials.

Upon receipt of your donation, CSC Habitat will mail you an official statement listing the items donated and their value, which each donor determines.

Shopping at the Re-Store

The CSC Habitat for I-Humanity Re-Store provides a unique shopping opportunity for Midlands residents. Essentially a resale store, the Re-Store carries donated and surplus building materials such as hardware, lumber, plumbing and light fixtures, paint and windows. Other items commonly found in the Re-Store are appliances, electronics, furniture, wallpaper, drapes, exercise equipment and children's items.

Items are sold at greatly reduced prices. Also, many items that are discontinued elsewhere can be found in the Re-Store.

The Re-Store is the ideal shopping location for homeowners who can not afford prices at large home supply stores or for anyone who enjoys buying quality merchandise at bargain prices.

Every time you shop at the Re-Store, you know your purchase - however big or small - will help CSC Habitat for Humanity continue its mission of eliminating poverty housing from the Midlands.

Volunteering at the Re-Store

Without the support of volunteers, the Re-Store's full operation would not be possible, and CSC Habitat for Humanity would be lacking a vital component to its housing ministry. In addition to a staff manager, volunteers help in the Re-Store in a variety of capacities.

Volunteers support the Re-Store by assisting customers, scheduling and picking up donated items, cleaning and displaying merchandise, and cleaning and maintaining the facilities. Volunteer commitment varies depending on individuals' schedules. While some volunteers work in the Re-Store several times a week, others volunteer weekly, monthly or on an as-needed basis.

As a Re-Store volunteer, you meet other volunteers who share your interest in CSC Habitat's housing ministry. You also meet many of the current and prospective homeowners who value the time you give to help them obtain safe, affordable homes.
